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

SSNAP Stroke Audit

Applies to: Pilot Users

To support with the [nationally mandated stroke audit \(SSNAP\)](#) we have introduced two new clinical documents:

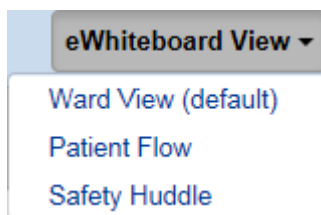



eDAN Improvements to include AKI and ReSPECT

Applies to: All Users

Amendments to the AKI results within eDAN:

- The highest AKI score will display for all admissions where there is a clinical diagnosis.
- Removed additional question to speed up completion within eDAN.

Added ReSPECT information:

- Added ReSPECT information around CPR decisions and advance statements. Selected information will display in eDAN if ReSPECT form was updated during admission for CPR and Advance statement.
- Reminder to GPs that patient has a CPR /Advance statement if ReSPECT completed in a previous admission.
