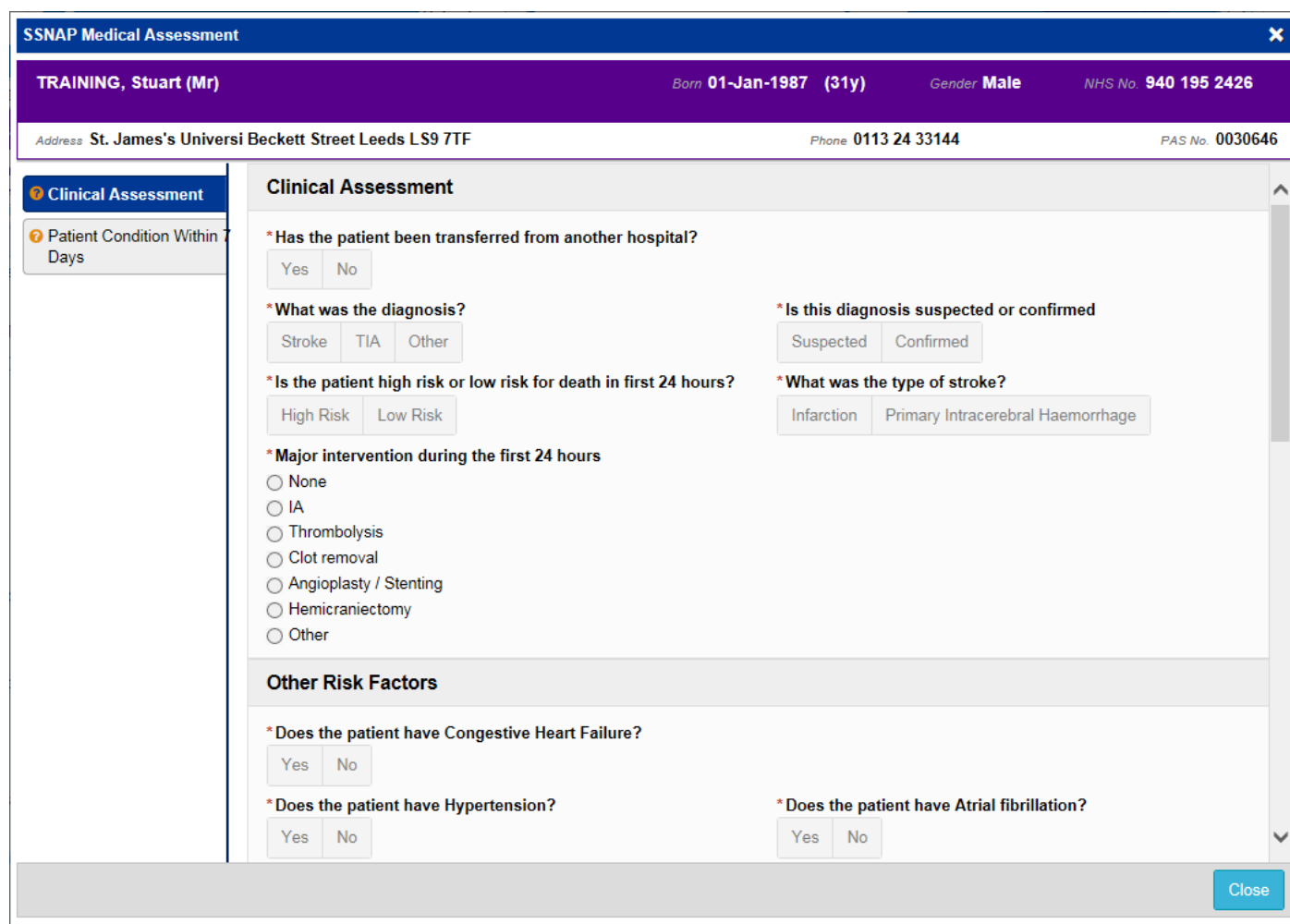

Where is the Child's Plan?

We are working on contributing Child's Plans (Child in Need) to Leeds Care Record. We have shared Child Protection and Looked After Plans in the first implementation.

What is a Child's Plan?

A Child's Plan (Child in Need) will be in a place where a child has needs that can be met through social work support. These needs could include complex needs, family support and many others. A Child's Plan is multi-agency. It can become an Early Help Plan when there is no further role for social work services, or be closed without further support where appropriate. It may end and be replaced by a Child Protection Plan or a Looked After Child Plan.

What is a Child Protection Plan?

A Child Protection Plan indicates that a multi-agency conference has agreed that a child has suffered or is likely to suffer harm. The Child Protection Plan will remain in place until a multi-agency conference including parents and carers agrees that this child is no longer at risk of harm or it is replaced by a Looked After Plan or Child's Plan (Child in Need).

What is a Looked After Plan?

A Looked After Plan indicates that a child is, or has been, looked after by the local authority either through the decision of a court, or through a voluntary arrangement. Children and young people who receive short breaks are legally "Looked After" if they are

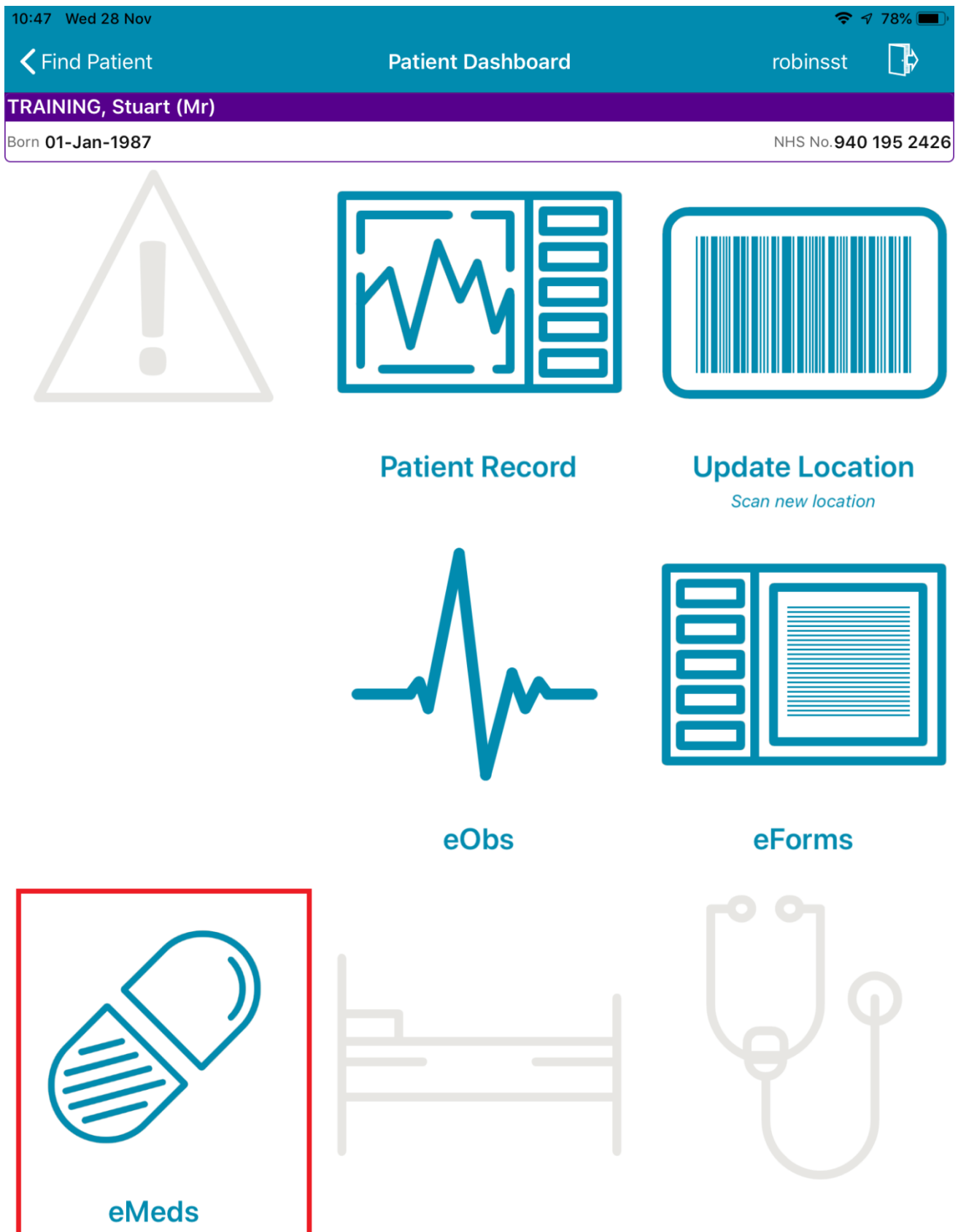

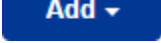
