Custom Patient List Improvements

Applies to: All Users

We have now introduced a *Category* filter into Custom Patient Lists. This will provide an improved user experience and rationalising the filters that are in use and their context. Based on feedback, the bed number has also been added to the Custom Patient Lists.



Following clinical feedback we have improved the *Resuscitation Intervention Event (Adult)* eForm.

Now includes the option of *Medical Emergency* alongside *Respiratory Arrest* and *Cardiac Arrest* which opens a comments box to detail the event.

Further improvements include:

- Airway/Breathing section - new comments box to describe the course of the airway management.
- Airway/Breathing section - ability to add additional airway devices.
- Interventions section - ability to choose IO access.
- New section to detail Post Arrest Drugs.
- Improvements to Post Resuscitation Care detailing destination of patient, support for transfer, escalation plan, next of kin update.

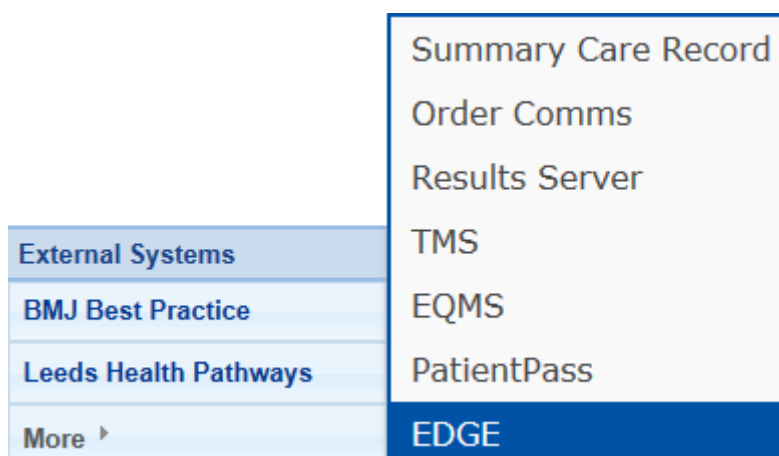
