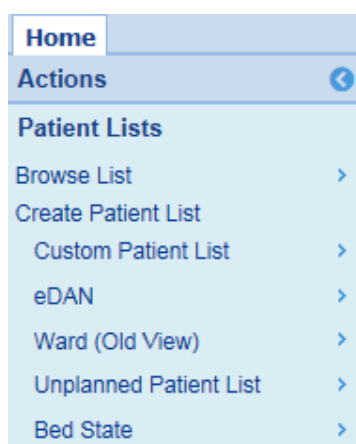
Custom Patient Lists Improvements


