An **alert**, in the **Patients Clinical Alerts** section, will indicate that the patient has an **Emergency Care Plan**.

The alert can be accessed via the **alerts column from the ward view (MPV)** or the **patient record (SPV)**.

Please then search for the **Emergency Care Plan** in the patients record for more information about the care required. Ensure the Care Plan is active by reviewing all the notes for this specialty.
