





Virtual Fracture Clinic Outcome

Applies to: Pilot Users

We have developed an electronic form for Virtual Fracture Clinic Outcomes. This improves upon the current Virtual Fracture Clinic support process which currently requires co-ordination of scans, A&E records and letters plus the completion of a spreadsheet of VFC outcomes which is used for contracting. PPM+ provides an easy means of consolidating this process:




