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PPM+ v3.2.13 Release Notes - 4th of August 2015

PPM+ is our flagship project and platform, which is delivering the Electronic Patient Record (EPR) for Leeds Teaching Hospitals staff and the Leeds Care Record (LCR) for GP Practices and Mental Health colleagues.

In the last month we have been preparing to pilot eDAN Lite for patients that are not provided with medication on discharge. We have also improved the Single Patient View and Patient Lists by displaying clinical alerts for unmatched test results and fixing the column headers.

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eDAN Lite for Live Pilot

Later this year the Trust will begin a gradual replacement of the Bluespier eDAN with a new one in PPM+. This will be released alongside the new eMeds system, MedChart. It will provide a fully integrated discharge summary, with medications and allergies automatically populating from MedChart.

Prior to this we will be piloting a “Lite” version of the new eDAN that is not integrated with MedChart and is only for use for patients that are not provided with medication on discharge. This pilot will enable us to gather feedback to help improve the new eDAN.
