New Features

Bed State Reporting

Applies to: All Users

The new Bed State report displays the current **live** inpatient bed state across the organisation and automatically refreshes once a minute. Figures in the report are driven by the completion of *Bed Management* and *Planning* columns in the Ward Patient List. The accuracy of this report is entirely dependent upon the correct and timely completion of this information. The default view shows bed totals for each CSU, i.e. number of empty beds, number of closed beds:

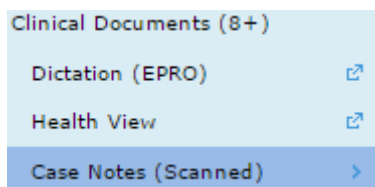
