New Features

eDID Improvements

Applies to: eDID Users

In line with improving the Trust's discharge processes, we have simplified the eDID (electronic Discharge Initiation Document) process to reduce the time taken to complete a full eDID from 30 minutes to roughly 5 minutes. This will save clinical staff valuable time when sending a referral to the Gateway (formerly known as SPUR) at <u>Leeds Community Healthcare</u>.
