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# New Features

## Discharge / Transfer Planning

Applies to: Leeds Teaching Hospital Users

LTHT is undertaking a review about effective use of our services called *Leeds Clinical Utilisation Review* (LCUR). This is to ensure our patients are in the most appropriate setting for their needs, which includes considering whether ongoing assessments or care needs can be provided elsewhere.

This relates to the Discharge / Transfer Planning columns, namely **EDD** (Expected Date of Discharge), **MFFD** (Medically Fit for Discharge), **Planning** and **Needed For Discharge / Transfer**:

# Shift-to-Shift Handover

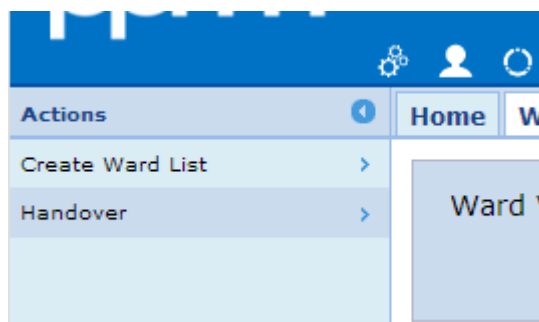
**Applies to:** Leeds Teaching Hospital Users

Handover provides support for ward-based shift-to-shift handover for nursing and medical staff. The clinician will be able to review key handover information at a patient level and proceed to the next patient.

If the record (Clinical Summary/Handover Comments/Jobs/Clinical Review) is updated via handover then this will also update the ward patient list / eWhiteboard columns.

Clinicians will be able to print off a table view of all handover details. Further enhancements to printing and filtering of relevant patients will follow in November.






















# Developments in PPM+

## Unplanned Patient List (UPL) Enhancements

Applies to: Pilot Users

Several enhancements have been made to the Unplanned Patient List (pilot users can access from Virtual Lists):

- The *Patient Location* column has now been renamed *Route of Entry*
- New columns to display *Current Location* and *Last Updated* (date/time)
- Patients are now separated into two sections: *Added* and *Updated* with the most recent at the top
