

Adult Critical Care Falls Assessment and Care Plan is now available in ppm+

The **Adult Critical Care Falls Assessment and Care Plan** eForm can be completed via the **PPM+ Mobile** app and the Desktop version of **PPM+**.



The eform can be accessed via **eForms** in the **PPM+ Mobile** app or by using the **Add Clinical Document** function on the desktop version of **PPM+**.

Enter **Adult Critical Care Falls Assessment and Care Plan** in the **Search Field** and select **Adult Critical Care Falls Assessment and Care Plan**. You can also save this to your **favourites** by clicking on the **star**.
